PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND OF THE 2¢-A-MEAL PROGRAM

1. The purpose of the 2¢-A-Meal Program is to meet the needs of hungry people and to address the systemic causes of hunger locally, nationally and internationally.
2. The Presbytery adopted the 2¢-A-Meal Program in 2001. Funds are made available by local churches and members participating in the program. Local churches keep a percentage of the money they raise (10%), and then forward the remainder to the Presbytery of West Jersey.

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Applications may be submitted by any organization within the bounds of the Presbytery of West Jersey that is actively seeking to meet the needs of hungry people or addressing the political, economic, and societal issues that cause hunger.
2. Application will be considered if they meet the mission statement of the Presbyterian Hunger Program “to alleviate hunger and eliminate its causes.”
3. Organizations not affiliated with the Presbyterian Church (USA) should ask the Session of the Presbyterian Church in their community to endorse their request.
4. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling, as received basis. Grants will be awarded only when funds are available.
